

TIS INTEC Group Targets Approved by SBT Aiming for 27.5% Reduction in Greenhouse Gas Emissions by 2030

Tokyo, Japan, August 4, 2021 –TIS Inc. (Headquarters: Tokyo, Japan), a member of the TIS INTEC Group, announced that the TIS INTEC Group's greenhouse gas emission reduction targets have been approved as science-based targets (SBT)*1, by an international initiative to combat climate change.



The TIS INTEC Group recognizes the importance of working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, a primary cause of climate change. In FY 2020, the Group set a target to reduce the greenhouse gas emissions from its business activities by 27.5% by FY 2030, from a fiscal 2019 base year.

On June 30, 2021, the Group's target was approved as SBT by the Science Based Targets initiative*2, stating that the TIS targets to reduce emissions are in line with the objective of the Paris Agreement*3.

The Group's newly approved greenhouse gas emission reduction targets are as follows.

- Scope 1 & 2*4: Commitment to reduce absolute Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 27.5% by FY 2030 from a fiscal 2019 base year
- Scope 3: Commitment to reduce absolute Scope 3 GHG emissions 27.5% by FY 2030 from a fiscal 2019 base year

(The target for Scope 1 and 2 emissions reduction is considered to be in line with the goal of limiting the increase in global average temperature to well-below 2°C.)

With the brand message of "make society's wishes come true through IT," the TIS INTEC Group believes that its mission is to help solve social issues using digital technology. Global environmental problems are part of these issues, and in particular, dealing with the climate change/global warming is becoming more critical every day.

In order to help realize a sustainable society, the Group will continue to implement climate change mitigation measures, while providing customers with IT support to tackle challenges of climate change, and working to help solve global environmental issues.

*1. Science-based targets (SBT):

Science-based targets are emissions reduction targets in line with what the latest climate science says is needed to meet the goals of the Paris Agreement.

*2. Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi):

The Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) is a collaboration between the CDP (formerly the Carbon Disclosure Project), the United Nations Global Compact, the World Resources Institute (WRI) and the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF). The SBTi defines and promotes best practice in science-based target setting and independently assesses companies' targets.

*3. Paris Agreement: According to Article 2.1a of the Paris Agreement, the aim is to hold the increase in the global average temperature to well below 2°C above preindustrial levels, while pursuing efforts to limit the temperature increase to 1.5°C above preindustrial levels.

*4. Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions: The calculation method used as international standard for companies to calculate and report their greenhouse gas emissions. It was defined by the GHG Protocol around 2001, Scope 1 as direct emissions from the company, Scope 2 as indirect emissions from purchased electricity, etc., and Scope 3 as other indirect emissions, including from the company's value chain.
